The system is built into both the Honda Civic and the Honda Accord. It is the standard Anti Theft Device for most Honda Vehicles. What Is Honda Anti Theft System?

How do I get my Honda Civic out of anti-theft mode? To reset the security system or immobilizer in your 2018 honda civic vehicle, depress the key fob's panic button for five seconds before pressing the lock button twice standing 10 feet away from the vehicle. Follow by depressing the unlock button twice and your immobilizer should be reset.

If your car's anti-theft system isn't working correctly, you'll need to find a way to shut the system off so your car will return to normal operation. Method 1 of 3: Check your key and cylinder. Step 1: Check your key fob battery. A car's anti-theft system may activate if your key fob battery is dead and hasn't disabled the system.

There were some reports on here of people losing all power while driving and other issues electrical which seemed to be related to a loose battery cable. I'm guessing you may have the same issue. Honda always had an anti-theft code to unlock the car or reenable after losing power and I'm guessing the push button is similar to the radio aspect.



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
