Some cities restrict parking even on private property. You may want to check with your city. Generally, as long as the vehicle is operable and registered, and not parked on the lawn or front yard, you should be okay. Non-registered vehicles parked where they can be seen could result in some sort of citation or violation of a blight ordinance.

To buy land that is not listed for sale, you need to carefully plan and research. Understand your budget and financing options, location and zoning, network, conduct due diligence, and negotiate effectively.

The Land Registration Act 2002 replaced the 1925 Act, greatly increasing the triggers for compulsory registration. All land bought, sold, gifted or mortgaged must now be registered at the Land Registry. If you have owned your home from before 1990, and not taken a mortgage since, your property may not be registered. So how can you find out?
