Transfer of Title. Sale: A sale of land requires a Deed of Sale, and the title must be transferred to the buyer"s name. Whilst the level of storage capacity is low, this store captures water for the longest periods of time. VERIFYING THE LAND TRANSFER AT THE REGISTRY. The transfer documents are stored at the Land Registry. They are then forwarded to the Registrar for formal processing of the transaction. The transfer process happens by way of deed. A property deed is a formal, legal document that transfers one



person or entity"s rights of ownership to another individual or entity. The deed is the official "proof of transfer" for real estate, which can include land on its own or land that has a house or other building on it.

To transfer a property, you can usually just hand it over to the other person. However, for valuable property such as a vehicle or real estate, you will need to fill out certain paperwork and then record the transfer with the appropriate government agency.
