

Do dyson vacuums have lithium batteries

Dyson batteries have protection mechanisms/battery-saving triggers built into them to prevent the batteries from overcharging and catching fire/ degrading. (Source) This applies to most of their models with lithium-ion batteries, including V6, V7, V8, V10, and V11. Note that you do not have to fully charge them before every use.

Battery Capacity and Lithium-Ion Batteries. Dyson vacuums use lithium-ion batteries, which are known for their long lifespan and high energy density. However, over time, the battery's capacity may decrease, resulting in shorter run times and difficulty holding a charge.

It's reasonable to expect to replace a stick vac battery. I was willing to pay \$99 after four years of use from my V6, and I expect the replacement battery to last for another four years. However, cordless stick manufacturers should do better. They know the batteries will need to be replaced long before the rest of the vac wears out.

Certain lithium-ion replacement battery packs that have been used in some Dyson vacuums should be properly disposed of immediately after several fires had been reported.

Be careful here, Dyson batteries have the protection circuitry integrated into the battery pack, and DeWalt have it integrated into the tool. This means a DeWalt battery in a Dyson tool has no protection circuitry. The main risk is over-discharge, so if the battery has a charge meter on it then stop when it gets down to 1 bar.
