



## Engine system service required volvo xc60 power loss

This system helps to prevent skidding and loss of control in slippery conditions. Symptoms of the DSTC Service Required. Sometimes, the "DSTC Service Required" warning may be accompanied by noticeable symptoms that indicate DSTC problems. These symptoms can include: Traction Control Activation

Just happened on my '24 T8 V60 today, got restricted to 25mph with the gas engine running. I called Volvo from the car, and while waiting for my tow driver, the 25mph restriction went away, but the CEL and "propulsion system service required" message stayed. Drove it home and had the tow company pick it up from my house.

After doing these, the car should be fine and run well without engine power loss and zero reduced engine performance messages. Reduced Engine Performance Volvo Xc60. For folks who own a Volvo Xc60, the issue with reduced engine performance has been rooted to a number of causes.

Drivers may notice a dim "Propulsion System Service Required" message on the instrument panel upon starting the car; while this message is displayed the vehicle can run on electric power. Before the vehicle is set to switch over to the combustion engine, a second warning in the form of a turtle icon will appear, and the vehicle's speed ...

When you see the "Engine System Service Required" message on your Volvo, it's natural to be concerned. This alert indicates there may be an issue with your vehicle's engine system. No need to panic, but it's important to address the problem soon to avoid possible consequences.

When it detects the DPF needs to be regenerated, (burning off the soot trapped by the filter), the engine management system injects diesel into the exhaust stroke of each cylinder. This burns in the hot exhaust gas, raising temperature of the exhaust to that required for the regeneration process.

Use the correct engine oil: Ensure that you always use an engine oil that meets your Volvo's manufacturer specifications to avoid damage to the DPF. Proper maintenance, including appropriate oil changes and DPF care, will help you keep your Volvo engine system in optimal condition.

The service manager told me that Volvo USA advised them to update a specific software module. That apparently resulted in the check engine light going away, but the code came back after they drove it for a bit.

Required message up. Checked and very slow pulling off with max speed achievable around 75 (Although at one point on the motorway something appeared to happen and allowed full acceleration past 100) although after I slowed down it wouldn't pull again!

Now the check engine light is on. Message saying "Propulsion System Service Required". The drive range is a joke, i got bit up to 8 miles and depleted 8 miles of range in 1 mile. To add to the driving experience I can feel jerkiness as the engine turns on and off. Gas mileage is less than 20 mpg. Had any one experienced any thing like this?

Check the gas cap. Make sure it is tight. Make sure the o ring on the inside isn't rotted or cracked. A lot of times this warning light means low fuel system pressure, which is almost always a gas cap not screwed all the way or leaking air.

My 2016 xc60 has engine service required and loss of power when driving also oil overfill when I checked it. Yesterday. ... During acceleration it suddenly lost power and the onboard computer send a message saying "enging system. Kevin. Diagnostic technician. ... 2010 Volvo XC60 Power steering fluid is pushing out of reservoir any ideas. When you ...

the trick you tried will only reset the "yearly service" (oil etc service) light, the "engine system service required/urgent" message is different, and usually doesn't reset until the fault that made it occur is fixed, I have an intermittent fault with my s60, it throws up this system service msg along with slow acceleration whenever I warm start ...

I took this straight to my local dealership who took the car into a service bay for ten minutes and told me that the problem was sorted, the turbo needed to be reset they told me?

The patient is a 2001 volvo v70 2.4 non turbo 170bhp. The car has come up with the message "ENGINE SYSTEM SERVICE REQUIRED" and suffered from rough idle. Vida Dice revealed the following codes: ECM-91B7 ECM-9150. ... S60 2011+ and V60 2015+ and XC60 2010-2018; 2017+ S90, V90, V90 Cross Country; Volvo XC90 2016+

Press the remote key into the ignition slot and press START/STOP ENGINE. Ignition mode II Press the remote key into the ignition slot and press START/STOP ENGINE for approx. 2 seconds. Ignition mode III (engine start) Start the engine 1. Fasten the seat belt. WARNING: Before starting the engine, check that the seat, steering wheel and mirrors ...

you would probably need the codes read to find out why its coming up, then once you know the cause then you can fix the reason it is coming up, on my V50 2.0d I had that message, and the codes it gave were a pending low turbo boost, in the end I tracked it down to a broken wire on the manifold air pressure switch, fixed the problem and the code went away.

"DSTC" & "Engine System Service Required" on dash, car now in limp mode [SOLVED] - Fuel injector failure ... It's already booked in for next week at the local Volvo specialists, so I'm not trying to be a scab and avoid paying for a proper fix, it's just that the car is stuck in a place that would be desperately awkward to get a ...

What to Do When You See the Message. If your Volvo displays the "Engine System Service Required" message, it is important not to ignore it. Continuing to drive the vehicle without addressing the underlying issue can potentially cause further damage and lead to expensive repairs.

2022.5 XC90 ER, 32 days old, 1,290 miles. Driven mostly on battery, only used one tank so far, charged every day. No problems (except a couple squeaks) until Friday evening when this popped up when the ignition was turned on: "Propulsion system: Service required." It had been driven on multiple short trips earlier in the day.
