The panels themselves are probably the first thing that comes to mind when you think about going solar, but solar panels represent less than a third of the total solar equipment costs. You can expect all required solar equipment, including supply chain costs and sales tax, to cost \$13,800-about 46% of the total system price.

The cost per watt is what you pay for each unit of power of your solar energy system. Think of it a little like "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84.

On average, it takes five to 10 years to pay back the cost of solar panels, and over their lifetime, these panels can save you anywhere from \$25,500 to \$33,000 on electricity expenses. Featured ...
