2. Use "how much + non-count nouns". How much time do we have? How much stress does she have? How much sugar do we need? How much money did she spend? Sometimes, we do not need the noun. We can do this when the noun is easily understood by the listener. How much did she spend? (=How much money did she spend?)

Use "how many" when referring to a plural, countable quantity of something. When using "how much" with countable nouns, use it to refer to the amount of money paid for something. When using "how many" with uncountable nouns, use it to refer to a portion or unit of the substance.

Adults can take one or two ibuprofen 200mg tablets (200mg to 400mg) three or four times daily if they need to. You should only take ibuprofen every 4 to 6 hours. How much is used with uncountable nouns or mass nouns. Uncountable nouns or mass nouns are nouns that are not easily counted, like liquids or non-physical nouns, or objects that are considered masses (sand or grass).
