Rechargeable batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Any rechargeable battery that weighs up to 11 pounds and is under 300 watt hours is accepted. There's no charge for recycling. Many local districts host collection events for residents to drop off batteries.

Can I recycle batteries? Depends on the type of battery. Rechargeable batteries (those found in your Kobalt cordless drill, for example) can be recycled at certain retailers, including Lowe's. Simply follow the instructions at the Recycling Center (usually found near the front of a Lowe's store) for proper rechargeable battery recycling.
