The announcement comes a week after the African Development Bank (AfDB) agreed to provide US\$50 million to Eritrea to fund the installation of a 30MW PV, 15MW battery energy storage project near Dekemhare. The project, covered by sister site PV Tech, would also require the construction of a new substation and transmission line.

Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) solve this variability. GEAPP aims to enable ~200MW of BESS by 2024 through a mix of direct GEAPP high-risk capital and other concessional and commercial funding. By doing this we can reframe battery storage as a pathway to a reliable, renewable energy future and seed this \$100 billion market.

Unlocking Africa's enormous renewable energy potential will require massive investments in solar and wind



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energy and battery energy storage systems (BESS) will help reduce the variability of electricity supply from the resulting power systems and support the integration of greater renewable energy into the grids.

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
