In our article exploring the cost of solar panels in the UK, we revealed that a typical 3.5kW solar panel system in 2023 costs £5,500, ... Unusually, GB-SOL reveals prices upfront without making you apply for a quote: the slates cost £294/m², which equals £8,449 for a 4kW system (around £2,112/kW). Installation is an extra £2,200.

Solar installations on slate roofs typically cost a bit extra, as they require more care, time, tools, specialist skills, and replacement tiles than other projects. Just as it's worth waiting longer for a better end product, it's



also usually worth paying a bit more for a job well done.

On average, solar roof tiles cost between £13,000 to £16,200. In contrast, the usual cost of solar panels would be £5,000 - £6,000 for the same size. Overall, solar roof panels in the UK can cost between £5,500 and £16,000, ranging from 1kW to 4kW systems. A 1kW solar tile setup can start at £5,500 but the labour costs push it up to £8,050.
