Rechargeable batteries are used in items such as phones, laptops, tablets and rechargeable tools. ... Before recycling non-working batteries, be sure to prepare them properly to avoid fire and injury. It's best to recycle non-working batteries within 6 months of removal.

Single-use, non-rechargeable batteries: ... Learn about infrastructure investments to improve the nation's battery recycling programs. EPA released a report analyzing the impacts of end-of-life lithium-ion batteries, generally from consumer devices (e.g., cell phones, tablets, vacuums, etc.), going into the municipal solid waste management ...

The lithium-ion battery recycling process is more complex than other types of e-waste. This complexity can make it challenging to find local recycling centers equipped to handle them. ... When damaged, these rechargeable batteries can release fine particles--known as PM10 and PM2.5--into the air. These tiny particles, less than 10 and 2.5 ...

Additionally, there is a recycling law for rechargeable batteries with Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb) and Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd). Manufacturers of rechargeable batteries are required to establish and maintain a system for the proper collection, transportation and processing of used Ni-Cd and small sealed lead batteries. Call2Recycle ...

This is an organization funded by battery manufacturers that collects and recycles or safely disposes of applicable batteries. Unlike the rechargeable battery program, there is currently no national stewardship law for free recycling of single-use batteries such as AAA, AA, 9V, C, or D cell - except in Vermont.

The Programme also provides a Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme Education Kit, which includes a poster, CD-ROM game, two game boards and colour worksheets for promoting rechargeable battery recycling in schools. ...

Rechargeable 9-volt batteries, AA and AAA batteries and D cells for household use look like alkaline batteries. The difference is they fit compatible plug-in chargers. Rechargeable batteries are recycled. Look for the battery recycling seals on rechargeable batteries. Tip: Remove batteries from broken cordless phones, smartphones and laptops.
