How Much Does It Cost To Remove And Reinstall Solar Panels? To disengage and reinstall, most solar technicians and companies will charge an overall amount of between \$1000 and \$6500 on residential property. One solar cell is 6'x6' squared, and the cost per square panel is between \$20-\$40 per cell.

Many times, the solar panel installation company will charge a nominal fee to remove and replace the panels if you are leasing the panels from them since they do want to keep you as a customer. That fee always depends on certain factors such as the amount of solar panels installed on the roof, how busy the solar company is, the age of the solar ...
