



Tariffs on chinese solar panels

US, Europe target forced labor with the import ban. In addition to the specific tariffs on solar panels and cells from China, on 23 December, President Biden signed the Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act. The law bans imports into the US of goods made by forced labor in the Xinjiang region in China, effective from 21 June 2022.

WASHINGTON (AP) -- President Joe Biden on Tuesday vetoed a congressional resolution that would have reinstated tariffs on solar panel imports from Southeast Asia, settling for now a long-running dispute over whether to punish China for trade violations that bypass U.S. rules limiting imports of cheap solar panels from Asia.

In 2018, President Donald Trump announced tariffs on all overseas-made cells and panels. Later that year, Chinese-made products received an additional 25% tariff. China's share of imports to the U.S. fell to less than 1%. The area chart depicts the market share of U.S. solar imports by country.

Members of Congress took aim at Mr. Biden's suspension of the penalties after a U.S. trade court ruled in December that four Chinese companies illegally tried to evade American tariffs on solar ...

In making their complaints, the solar companies argued that additional tariffs are necessary to account for how Chinese companies have moved much of their solar manufacturing out of China and into other countries in Southeast Asia to circumvent trade restrictions.
