The Old Power Cell is a Hardmode summoning item that, when used deep within the Jungle Temple, summons the Golem boss. Unlike Lihzahr Power Cells, the Old Power Cell is not usable at a Lihzahr Altar and can be used before Plantera has been defeated. Using a normal Lihzahr Power Cell at the Lihzahr Altar before Plantera is defeated will not summon Golem, meaning ...

The Solar Tablet is a Hardmode event-summoning item used to summon a Solar Eclipse may only be used during the day (from 4:30 AM to 7:29 PM), causing the eclipse to begin immediately, regardless of the time. The eclipse lasts until 7:30 PM of the current day. Solar Tablets have a 1/5 (20%) chance to be found in Lihzahr Chests in the Jungle Temple. ...

Summoning. Golem is summoned by using the ? Open / Activate key on the Lihzahr Altar, located in the Jungle Temple's final, largest chamber, while at least one Lihzahr Power Cell is in the player's inventory. One Lihzahr Power Cell is contained within each of the Jungle Temple's Lihzahr Chests, and they can also be dropped rarely by Lihzahrs or Flying Snakes with a ...

The Star Cell is a Hardmode, post-Lunatic Cultist enemy that spawns in the area of the Stardust Pillar during the Lunar Events floats slowly towards the player but can move at a faster rate if the player begins moving away from it. Upon death, it splits into multiple Mini Star Cells. If these Mini Star Cells are not dealt with, they will grow into a full-sized Star Cell, that can also split ...

I created another world, found another temple, and another alter. When i tried to activate it again, the same thing ...

Disagree on reducing the Lihzhard Power Cell and Solar Tablet Fragment drop rates. They're supposed to be semi-common. There are chests that can provide Power Cells, but if you want to farm Golem or you luck out, you don't want to spend forever trying to get a Power Cell to fight Golem again.

The Flying Snake is a flying Enemy that spawns primarily in the Jungle Temple, alongside Lihzahrd. The only spawning requirement appears to be that the player stand in front of the Temple background wall. Flying Snakes and Lihzahrds will begin to spawn if the player stands in front of natural Lihzahrd Brick Wall at the entrance to the Temple, even if Hardmode has not ...

The Star Cell is a Hardmode, post-Lunatic Cultist enemy spawned by the Stardust Pillar during the Lunar Events.
