



Where can i take batteries to be recycled

Did you know that the automotive battery is the most recycled product in the world? 99% of lead acid batteries are recycled. However, every year, an estimated 1.8 million used batteries are not responsibly recycled. When a lead-acid battery is not properly recycled, it can cause lead, acid and mercury to be deposited into lakes, streams and landfills.

Yes, you can recycle lithium-ion batteries, but they require special handling. Take them to certified recycling centers, electronics retailers with battery takeback programs, or hazardous waste collection sites. Avoid throwing them in the trash, as they pose fire risks and contain harmful chemicals. Proper recycling helps recover valuable ...

Household Battery Recycling. Household batteries come in two main forms: rechargeable and single-use. The extent to which each can be recycled depends on a variety of factors including battery type and materials able to be recovered from the recycling process. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency:

Note: Bulbs and batteries can't be combined in one kit, so if you need to recycle both, be sure to order a kit for each. Fill the kit with your spent bulbs or batteries. Load it up all at once or keep it handy to fill as needed.

These electronics can be recycled through E-Cycle Wisconsin. If storing batteries for recycling, you can reduce fire risk by taping ends of batteries with clear packing tape or putting each battery in an individual plastic bag, and storing them in a non-metal, leakproof container with a lid (such as a plastic bucket). Glass. Glass, especially glass food and beverage containers, can be recycled over and over again. In the United States in 2018, 12.3 million tons of glass were generated, 31.3 percent of which was recycled. Making new glass from recycled glass is typically cheaper than using raw materials.

You must take batteries to an authorized recycling center, a universal waste handler or a household hazardous waste disposal facility. When you know how to dispose of batteries, you can help the environment. Dropoff sites typically accept rechargeable batteries for recycling. For single-use batteries, you can get a mail-order recycling kit.
