



Where to dispose lipo batteries

Before thinking about disposing of LiPo or semi solid state batteries, it is better to first try to recycle it. If recycling is not an option, you should dispose of batteries by following a few steps. First, make sure that the battery is fully discharged .

How to Dispose of Puffed Lipo Batteries. The proper way to dispose of a swollen lipo battery is the same as what you would do when you throw out any old battery. You need to discharge it completely first. The two main methods that people use to discharge a battery completely is to hook it up to a light bulb or to put it in a bucket of saltwater.

For safety reasons, its best that LiPo cells be fully discharged before disposal (however, if physically damaged it is NOT recommended to discharge LiPo cells before disposal - see below for details). The batteries must also be cool before proceeding with disposal instructions. To dispose of LiPo cells and packs: 1.
