



# Zimbabwe energy storage project site progress

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The AfDB invited consulting firms to "indicate their interest in providing services under the Sustainable Energy Fund for Africa (SEFA)"s Africa Hydropower Modernisation Programme (AHMP) to support the Bank and its clients as consultants for the preparation of: Feasibility study for Floating Solar Project on the Lake Kariba reservoir."

A pumped hydroelectric energy storage (PHES) power plant will be built in Zimbabwe. It's the content of an agreement that has recently been reached between the Zimbabwe National Water Authority and Ngonyezi Projects, a company based in Pretoria, South Africa. It will be operated by a solar photovoltaic power plant.

China's ZTE Corporation has completed the feasibility study for Zimbabwe Power Company's (ZPC) Insukamini solar project, and is finalising an application for a concessional loan from the Export-Import Bank of China, the Herald reported. ZPC and ZTE signed a contract for the construction of the 100MW Insukamini solar project in October 2015.
